Footprint of 2012-13

EMCO Foundation had great year where ongoing projects and some of the new initiatives had made remarkable impact on lives of people with whom we work. Through various initiatives we reached to 8636 people during the year and 39368 people so far in the journey of transforming lives. New initiatives like establishment of E-class in TMC's Dhokali School, counselling of students, etc. has value added in the overall impact of programs.

Municipal Corporation officials, School management and students admitted the contribution of EF Parivartan project in achieving impressive SSC results in 2013 across schools where EF Parivartan



is implemented. TMC School student Mr. Jaffar Iqbal Abdul Rahim scored 90.18%, JMC School students Ms. Nanda Jagan Nanavare got 70.80%, Student of MP School in Jalgaon Ms. Ekta Bhaskar Kosti scored 81.45%. These students benefited with Parivartan classes where emphasis was given on how to do proper study, stress management, fearless study

and overall confidence building. Career guidance program has given them a direction to choose the suitable education stream for better career path; all these students have decided to go for science field.

All 400 students of our Shiksha project are continuing their school education with greater confidence. Tobacco awareness program with Municipal school students has created remarkable impact as many students given up the habit of chewing/smoking tobacco.

In response to the appeal by Jalgaon Commissioner EMCO Foundation donated 15 water tanks of 2000 liter capacity which will be used for water storage in the drought affected villages in Jalgaon district.



Celebration of World Environment Day



Our commitment towards Earth's Environment preservation world environment day was marked on 5th June 2013 at our Thane company premises. It was organized together by Corporate Safety & Quality department and EMCO Foundation. Our Vice Chairman Mr. Shailesh Jain inaugurated the event by planting sapling along with senior management people and officials. More than 25 saplings planted in the company premises.
